#### **Treasury**

There are not a whole lot of updates for the treasury since November. We have collected \$6016.28 in dues so far this year. Our quarterly dues to NASCOE have been \$5,000.00 through the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter. Just a reminder that \$55 of every member's dues goes to NASCOE. Our rates are one of the lowest around.

Our greatest expense so far this year was sending our delegates to the National Convention in Savannah, Georgia at a cost of \$2,630.56. We spent \$295.61 to provide lunch at several new employee orientation meetings while providing an overview of what WASCOE offers and the benefits of becoming a member.

WASCOE receives a stipend from NASCOE for delegates to the National Convention. The stipend is calculated by taking the cost of airfare from the state's capital city to the destination, multiplied by the state's amount of membership, multiplied by the number of delegates. Currently our membership is at 52%. The greater our membership, the more NASCOE helps to defray the cost with their stipend.

Coming up is our annual WASCOE convention on April 21, 2023 at the Metropolis Resort in Eau Claire. The cost of the convention is \$14 for lunch, \$23 for dinner, and if you register for both lunch and dinner, the total is \$30. Dillard Financial Services, Inc. will make a donation to WASCOE based on the number of attendees. The more attendees, the larger the donation! So, make your plans to attend!

Don't forget about our cash raffle! There are 250 tickets being sold at \$20 each. There are \$2,000 in prizes to be awarded. The prizes are:  $1^{st}$  - \$1,000,  $2^{nd}$  - \$500,  $3^{rd}$  - \$250,  $4^{th}$  - \$100,  $5^{th}$  - \$50, and  $7^{th}$  - \$50. The net income taken in helps with our general fund which is used for delegate and convention expenses, as well as general operating expenses.

#### Website

Our website contained outdated information and some areas were incomplete. It took a weekend, but I cleaned it up by updating each page with current committee chairs, emails, applicable committee page links, and more. I put designed it with a more consistent look and format for each page so it would be familiar when browsing each page and where information may be located.

A new page titled, "WI FSA News" is where you will find information regarding Wisconsin-specific information such as shared management updates, WASCOE Officer and STC/SED meetings, etc. The Benefits page was updated with all the benefits available as noted on the NASCOE benefits page. The Conventions and Events page has current information on our convention as well as everything relating to the Midwest Area Rally which will be in Grand Rapids, Michigan from April 27-29, 2023.

WASCOE offers a traditional scholarship for our state. In 2023, WASCOE set the awards in the amount of \$1,000, \$750 & \$500. NASCOE has an online application for scholarships and offers many types but, remember WASCOE only offers the traditional scholarship.


To be eligible for the Traditional Scholarship:

- Applicants must be a NASCOE member's child, or a member's legal dependent;
- Applicants may be either a graduating high school senior or first-year college freshman enrolled as a full-time student with a minimum of 12 hours at an accredited college, university or trade school.
- Member's dues must be paid, and membership kept current for the past 5 years, or if less than 5 years, continuous membership has been maintained since becoming a NASCOE member within the first 12 months of becoming a permanent employee. Please check with a membership chair if you are unsure of your scholarship eligibility.

This scholarship can only be won once at the Area and National level.

December is the time to apply for the scholarships with a deadline of January 15<sup>th</sup>. About a week after the deadline ends, the chair receives the listing of applications received nationally. From there, membership is verified and from those found to have met the membership requirements, they are then evaluated by 3-5 judges within the state. The membership verification is sent to the Midwest Area Chair and those found eligible based on membership are then also evaluated also at the Area level. The Area winners are then forwarded to the National level for judging.

In 2023, we only had one applicant so, we would like to recognize and congratulate the 2023 winner:

#### **Payroll Deduction**

By enrolling in payroll deduction, you also ensure you get the \$5 discount! To enroll in payroll deduction, complete the membership application, the FSA-444, withholding amount memo, and return them to our treasurer, Jon Beam, at the Outagamie County Office.

#### **Check and Mail**

If you wish to pay by check, complete the membership application and mail it with a check made out in the amount indicated by your current grade to our treasurer, Jon Beam, at the Outagamie County Office. If mailed prior to July 31st, you can take a \$5 deduction from the amount indicated! Associate memberships are always at the rate of \$45 annually.




